THE GEORGE SEMENIUK SCHOLARSHIP

On November 10, 2005, we lost a very prominent figure in the province of Saskatchewan.

George Semeniuk dedicated his life to the labour movement, fighting hard for working people to ensure a safe workplace and fair wage for all. George was the type of person who was widely respected by his union peers and that was also reflected in his life-long passion for politics.

George's achievements include: President of UFCW Canada Local 234P (1956-1962), President of the UFCW Canada Saskatchewan Provincial Council (1968-1970), Saskatchewan Council Representative (1970-1988), Saskatchewan UFCW International Representative (1988), and UFCW Canada Western Assistant (1989-1997). George also served as Saskatchewan Federation of Labour President, Canadian Labour Congress Vice-President and on numerous other boards and labour councils during his career. George retired from UFCW Canada in 1997 but continued his contributions as an advisor to the Saskatchewan Minister of Labour, and a Labour Representative volunteer for the United Way of Saskatoon and Area.

In 2006, the UFCW Canada Saskatchewan Provincial Council proudly introduced the George Semeniuk Scholarship. Last year's winner was Muhammad Shaher Yar. Muhammad's father, Saleem, is a UFCW 248P member who works at Star Egg in Saskatoon.

We are proud to continue the scholarship again this year.

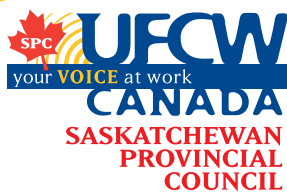
This distinctive scholarship will be presented to the candidate who displays significant involvement within their community, union, political and/or volunteer organizations. Academic standards will be considered secondary as criteria for this scholarship.

George was a firm believer that the measure of a person was not in how much they knew, but how they applied themselves to better the lives of people around them.

The George Semeniuk Scholarship will be presented annually in the amount of **\$1,000** to the deserving recipient. UFCW Canada Saskatchewan members, spouses, and their children attending post secondary education are eligible to apply.
